LET'S CREATE A NETWORK – AGAINST CORRUPTION!

The “Let’s create a network against corruption!” project is a partnership between the Association for Democratic Society from Zagreb, Faculty of Law from Split, Association “Dobra” from Metkovic and Centre for Sustainable Development from Imotski. It’s aim is to strengthen the capacity of civil society organizations to improve transparency and responsiveness of public administration, especially at a local level, and to raise public awareness of the benefits of transparency and good governance.

An editorial board for media coverage of anti-corruption topics (website, TV shows, radio shows) was established within the project. Seminars were held for journalists, local civil society organizations and representatives of local public administration in Dubrovnik-Neretva County and Split-Dalmatia County, and the City of Zagreb. There was community work in smaller local communities and information booths for citizens were organized.

Editorial board members also plan study visits to European organizations that have applicable experience in tackling corruption.

We are undertaking a policy analysis of the Anti-corruption strategy from 2015 to 2020, and the Strategy for development of public administration for the same period. We are also developing a case study on the risks of corruption at a local level and possible solutions to its prevention.

The project began on 1st January 2015 and ends on 1st January 2017.
